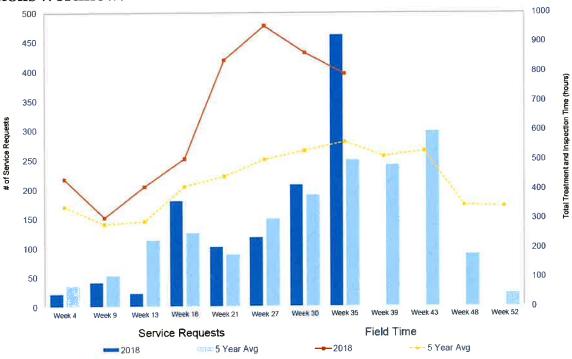

Operations Summary:

The operations department rolled out new operating procedures in August regarding the inspection and treatment of swimming pools. These new procedures will make it easier for residents to comply, while reducing the resources necessary for the District to monitor and manage these sites. The new procedures also define a strict standard that needs to be met in order to make a claim of public nuisance and creates a minimum standard by which inspection warrants are appropriate.

The District received 462 service requests in August, more than doubling demand over last month. While an increase in demand for service is expected and planned for as the season progresses, we are seeing significant increases year over year as compared to historical averages. We attribute these trends to the aggressive biting pressure of invasive Aedes, however, the annexation of new cities whose residents are taking advantage of newly available services has continued to exacerbate the increase. Although the current demand requires a majority of the department's resources, the new organizational structure has allowed us to redirect resources as needed to respond in a timely and meaningful way.

The flow of the San Gabriel River has been reduced significantly over the last month resulting in a decrease of blackfly development, giving residents in our foothill communities a window of relief. Scheduled water releases will resume in late October creating the constant flow that blackfly need to develop. The District will respond with a larvicide treatment schedule to minimize blackfly populations and curb the biting pressure. In addition, the city of Pasadena has repaired an important pipeline

that serves as an alternate conveyance system to move water from the San Gabriel Dam to the Azusa Light and Water District. This gives us an opportunity to coordinate with public works who can divert water from the river periodically to maximize the efficacy of our treatments.

I. Mosquito Collections and Mosquito Pools for Arbovirus Surveillance

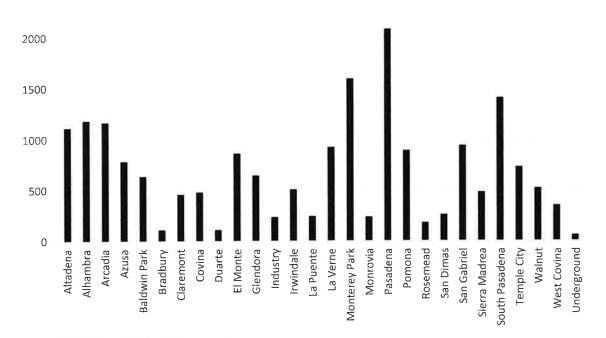

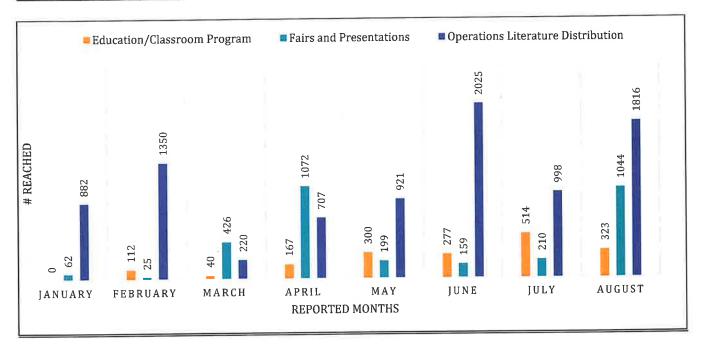

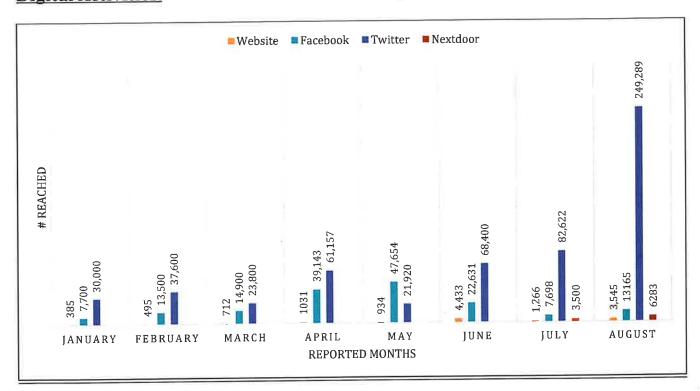
